



PE and Sport Grant

Background

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport, to be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. Funding has been allocated to all maintained and state-funded schools with primary phase pupils from 1 September 2013. A typical primary school receives about £9,250 annually in the academic year 2014/15. Funding has continued for 2015/16.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

Our school

This is how we are using the funding:

- Continue to develop teacher skills and confidence in Outdoor Games and work alongside Derby County coaches.
- Identified teachers to work with Derby City SSP on delivering Dance and Gymnastics units.
- To identify pupils in year 3 and 4 who are non-participants in physical activity and set up 'Change for Life' club in the Spring and Summer Term.
- Increase the number of mini play leaders to lead lunchtime activities and provide training for year 5 and 6 pupils/midday supervisors.
- To set up a 'School Sport Committee' to increase pupil involvement in organising and leading sport and PE.
- Widen pupil's experiences of physical activities by providing more after school clubs/breakfast clubs.

- Continue to increase the number of intra school competitions and increase number of pupils participating and being successful in competitive school sports.
- Children to take part in a Sports Week linking to the Olympics in Rio. Pupils have opportunity to try new sports/activities.
- To identify G&T pupils and set up links with local sports clubs.
- To implement pupil assessment and teacher assessment across the school.

- To provide non-contact time for the PE Coordinator so she can attend networking events, develop PE provision and support colleagues.
- providing cover staff to release teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- quality assuring the work of sports coaches and instructors employed to coach in PE lessons and after-school sports clubs
- buying into existing local sports networks such as school sport partnerships or community sports coaching initiatives
- providing training and payment for midday supervisors to introduce playground games at breaks and lunchtimes
- establishing and deliver a system to enable regular, inter-house sports competitions for pupils of all ages
- paying for transport, for pupils to attend out of school competition and sporting events.
- providing funding to enable Bikeability to take place in school. By the end of Key Stage 2 all children will have had the opportunity to take part in Bikeability.
- introducing new initiatives such as Yogabugs for Year 3.
- purchasing equipment and teaching resources to develop a non-traditional activity such as Tri-golf.
- to explore replacement football goals and basketball hoops.

The impact of additional funding on improving the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision:

- All full time teachers received mentoring and coaching for 6 weeks with Derby County in Outdoor Games and teacher confidence has improved.
- Mini – Leaders lead lunchtime activities.
- New Derby City SSP Outdoor Games units implemented across the school.
- Children have opportunities to participate in a variety of Derby City SSP Competitions, 3 County competitions and 1 Regional competition.
- Increased number of children involved in inter-school competitions.

- SEN children involved in Derby City SSP – Boccia, Gymnastics/Trampolining and Tri Golf.
- Two hours of quality PE delivered in school for every child as part of the PE curriculum.
- The children took part in a variety of intra school competitions during the year.
- School achieved the Silver School Games Mark.
- Teachers attended targeted SSP CPD courses throughout the year.
